The Real Estate Lab @ INTERGEO is a professional initiative by DVW e. V., Wirtschaftsrat GDI-DE and HINTE Expo & Conference GmbH. It brings together experts from geoinformation, the real estate industry, public administration and academia with the aim of jointly developing real estate data as a strategic infrastructure and addressing it at the political level.

The Real Estate Lab sees itself as an open forum that brings together different perspectives and areas of expertise: the technical infrastructure of geodata, the economic demand for reliable real estate information, the legal and regulatory framework, and international practice. This combination makes the format unique – and gives it its particular ambition.

The format combines an open professional audience in the morning with a closed expert workshop in the afternoon: the morning open session includes plenary presentations and is open to all INTERGEO Conference visitors. The afternoon closed workshop focuses on use cases and discussion with invited participants. The day concludes with a joint stand party at INTERGEO.

The 2025 White Paper, »Real Estate and Its Data: Responsibility for the Future«, showed that Germany has one of the densest real estate data landscapes in Europe – but systematically uses it below its potential. Not because data is lacking, but because it is fragmented, insufficiently accessible from a legal perspective and technically not designed for the requirements of a data-driven economy.

REL 2026 makes this diagnosis tangible: through use cases that show what is already possible today, and through political impulses. These include real estate data as High Value Datasets at EU level, a legally established market transparency body for real estate data, and the use of the window of opportunity created by the EU Anti-Money Laundering Directive 2024/1640 until July 2029.
